Subject :- Certificate of Recognition to the schools under sub-rule (4) of Rule 11 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011, for the purpose of Section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Respected Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 10/01/2025 and subsequent correspondence with the school/the inspection of the school, as evidenced,

I, Education Officer (Primary), District Parishad Sangli, convey the grant of temporary recognition to **Greenery School, Sangli. (Subhashnagar, Behind Akashwani, Sangli) Taluka-Miraj, District- Sangli** for **Class 1st to Class 8th** for a period of three years from **01/04/2025 to 31/03/2028**.

The above recognition is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions: -

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond Class VIII.
2. The School shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure One) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure Two).
3. The School shall admit in Class I, to the extent of 25% of the total strength, children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in the neighbourhood and provide them free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. However, this parameter will also be followed in case of pre-primary classes also.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall receive reimbursement as per Section 12(2) of the Act, for which a separate bank account will be provided.
5. The society/school shall not collect any capitation fee and shall not subject the child or his/her parents to any screening procedure.
6. No child shall be denied admission in the school for lack of proof of age, on grounds of religion, caste or race, place of birth, or any of them.
7. (One) No child admitted to the school shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of primary education in that school.
(Two) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
(Three) No child is required to pass any Board examination till the completion of elementary education.
(Four) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23.
(Five) Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs shall be done as per provisions of the Act.

(Six) Teachers shall be appointed who possess minimum qualifications as laid down under Section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years.

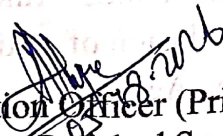
(Seven) The teachers shall perform their duties specified under Section 24(1) of the Act.

(Eight) The teachers shall not engage themselves in private tuition/teaching activities.

8. The school shall follow the syllabus prepared on the basis of the curriculum laid down by the appropriate authority.
9. The school shall admit students in proportion to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.
10. The school shall maintain the norms and standards specified in section 19 of the Act. At the time of the previous inspection, the facilities available in the school, were as follows:
 - Total Area of the School Campus :- 12100 Sq. Mtrs.
 - Total Built-up Area :- 4745.44 Sq. Mtrs.
 - Area of Playground :- 3715 Sq. Mtrs.
 - Number of Classrooms :- 13
 - Office-cum-Store-cum-Headmaster's Room :- Available
 - Separate toilet facilities for boys and girls with sufficient water for maintaining clean and hygienic conditions :- Available
 - Drinking Water Facility :- Available
 - Kitchen for cooking Mid-Day Meal :- Available
 - Teaching Learning Material / Games & Sports Equipment / Library :- Available
 - Availability of Reading Material :- Available
11. No unrecognized classes shall be run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of the school.
12. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purpose of education and skill development.
13. The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950.
14. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group, or association of individuals or any other persons.
15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant, and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statements of accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
16. The **UDISE number** allotted to your school is:

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This must be noted and quoted for any future correspondence with this office.
17. The school shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/District Education Officer from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government/Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in the working of the school.
18. Ensuring the renewal of the society's registration, if pending, should be prioritized.
